



## **Sullivan County Cidery Mural Design Contest Rules & Guidelines**

Seeking original works of art for an outdoor mural to be painted on the Sullivan County Public Cidery building hopefully during the summer of 2020.

### **Eligibility**

Students in Middle School through High School, living in Sullivan County, New Hampshire are eligible to participate. Parents or guardians must submit all information and artwork of students under the age of 18.

### **Artwork Specifications**

Theme of the mural is "Apples". The artwork should reflect some aspect of this theme. The work can be realistic or abstract and can be created in a variety of two dimensional media, including but not limited to: drawing with markers, colored pencils, pastels, painted with watercolors, tempera, acrylics, or created on the computer.

All original artwork must be 8 inches high by 16 inches.

All entries must be the original work of the student artist. Artwork cannot be copied from any source.

### **How to submit art work**

Art work to be considered must be photographed or scanned and submitted digitally as a jpeg and emailed to Dawn at [ddextraze@sullivancountynh.gov](mailto:ddextraze@sullivancountynh.gov). The photograph or scan should be a close-up of the artwork with as little border or background as possible. Emailed files can be up to 15 MB in size. Include the artist's name, address, email, and phone number with all work to be considered. Please direct your questions and inquiries to Dawn at the email address above.

### **Submission Deadline**

Art can be submitted anytime up to the deadline. The entry deadline for art work is 11:59 pm on May 15<sup>th</sup>.

### **Notification**

All student artists submitting work will be notified of the winning selections by email on or about May 25<sup>th</sup>.

### **Winning Art**

A component of all winning entries will be represented on the finished mural. Winning selections will be exhibited on the Sullivan County website with the artists name and city or town and at the murals unveiling. Winners will also receive a gallon of fresh pressed apple cider in the fall.

### **Rights**

By submitting art work to this competition students, parents or guardians agree to grant Sullivan County nonexclusive rights to post the artwork on the Sullivan County and Conservation District websites. Further, the work may be printed and electronically used to promote the Cidery and Sullivan County programs. All original art will be credited with the artists' name and copyright symbol when used or displayed.
